I am writing during unprecedented times for doctors and other healthcare providers. Like all of us, I'm certain that the COVID-19 pandemic has altered your personal and practice patterns. The COVID-19 pandemic has given Avellino the opportunity to make an immediate contribution outside of eye care. In order to meet public health demand for our AvellinoCoV2 test, we are adding 24/7 production shifts and putting 100% of the company's resources behind meeting this community health need. This means that we will not ship or process samples of AvaGen or Universal genetic tests for some period of time, depending on the public health demand. Any samples that were already received will be completed.

We appreciate your commitment to using the AvaGen and Universal genetic tests to diagnose and manage your patients with keratoconus and corneal dystrophies. You have our full commitment to making this novel genetic testing platform available to you and your colleagues as soon as we have done our part to help with the COVID-19 crisis.
